Contents:	The speaker would like to share with us his experience in construction safety and human reliability through in-depth analysis of a number of construction incidents and near-misses that were attributed by human errors. The presentation will highlight relevant key factors, like operational contexts, worker expectations, training, human-system interfaces, worker resource management and generic human-error mechanisms. Through the seminar, we could be able to have a better understanding on human-system interaction and its attribution to the industrial incident and near-miss, and that to identify ways and resources for prevention.
