Dr. Peacock is a Professor in the School of Science & Technology at SIM University, Singapore, and an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Industrial & Systems Engineering at the National University of Singapore. Dr. Peacock received his doctoral degree in Engineering Production from the University of Birmingham. He was a Professor in the Department of Safety Science at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University from 2005 to 2009. He worked as a discipline coordinating scientist for space human factors engineering in the National Space Biomedical Research Institute at Baylor College of Medicine/NASA from 2000 to 2004. He also worked as a manager in the Ergonomics Laboratory at General Motors from 1986 to 2000. Dr. Peacock is a fellow of the Institute of Ergonomics and Human Factors (UK) and a fellow of the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society (USA). He is a professional engineer and is on the Board of Certification in Professional Ergonomics.
